### Hurling

**1<sup>st</sup> Year Hurling:** We have 38 1<sup>st</sup> year Students on the hurling squad this year. The squad train once a week and numbers at each session are very encouraging. We played North Monastery AG in Charleville and won comfortably. We also participated in a blitz entering two teams, with all students getting game time. We have a very talented squad and they will hopefully keep progressing after Christmas.

Ard Scoil Rís broke through for goals at the start of each half in very poor conditions leaving Charleville well behind with 20 minutes to go in the game.
